- 6) How would you market your coaching business or ministry?
- 7) Set up an example of how you would coach a client and list ar eas where coaching is needed. Include at least two roadblocks you see, and how you would help a client overcome these road blocks in order for them to fulfill their goals.
- 8) Include a copy of your coaching agreement and feedback form with your report/paper.
- 9) What would be in your coaching tool box? This should not be a quick report, sketched out on a piece of paper. Take your time to sit before the Lord and prayerful ask the Holy Spirit to help you set up your first coaching business or ministry.
- 3. Write a two-three pages final paper on how this course has impacted your life, including your personality type and or motivational gifts and what you have learned from the course that you will be applying in your coaching practice or ministry.
- 4. Submit your paper on your coaching practice or the coaching ministry to your instructor in Lesson 12. Submit your final paper to your instructor with your final exam.
- 5. Earn at least a "B" on the Final Test. The Lesson Objectives and Discussion Questions are key to your success on the tests.
