The Power of Kingdom Emotions

Course Description:

The central principle of this course is that our heart (emotions) must be in alignment with our mind (beliefs) in order to experience a miracle of divine healing. If our mind says, "I believe," and our heart feels, "This is not going to happen," the power of God is short-circuited. Visionary meditations are included to lead people into their own personal encounters with Jesus, allowing them to **feel His emotions** of love, joy and peace for themselves, thereby turning on healthy genes and unleashing healing power throughout their body.

Course Objectives:

- You will discuss how you can guide your emotional responses.
- You will discuss the centrality of the emotions in our heart to the Kingdom of God.
- You will discuss the truth that we are transformed by what we gaze upon with the eyes of our heart.
- You will discuss the insights that the Observer Effect of quantum physics bring to our spiritual life.
- You will discuss the place and power of being able to see (be a witness) because of the baptism in the Holy Spirit.
- You will use each of the "New Creation Celebrations" at least seven times.
- You will discuss the need for and power of heightened Kingdom Emotions to bring forth miracles.
- You will discuss the power of prophetic gestures to release more spiritual energy when done with faith and passion.
- You will discuss the seven elements of the language of the heart.
- You will discuss the ingredients of heart faith as modeled by Abraham.
- You will discuss the meaning and significance of the Greek word *energeo*.
- You will discuss and engage in activities that strengthen your connection with the Holy Spirit and your awareness of that connection.
- You will discuss the principle that faith is energized by love.
- You will discuss the Greek word that the New Testament writers used to describe the love that they saw Jesus expressing.
- You will discuss the differences between love and compassion.

- You will discuss how your feelings of gratitude toward the Lord can be increased by spending time "on the other side of the mountain," and you will do so.
- You will discuss the natural and supernatural power of living in a spirit of thankfulness.
- You will discuss the meaning and power of "epigenetics."
- You will discuss how to experience healing for negative cellular memories.
- You will discuss how to recognize and release any generational issues that are affecting your spiritual and physical health.
- You will state the meaning of the Greek word *dai-monizomai*.
- You will state and experience the seven prayers that can heal your heart.
- You will discuss the power of agreement within.
- You will discuss Satan's strategy to deceive us and how we can take every thought captive.
- You will discuss the meaning and power of a godly imagination.
- You will state the meaning and benefits of heart coherence.
- You will learn a variety of prayer approaches so that the Spirit has the tools necessary to lead you into your most effective prayer times.
- You will actively cooperate with the Spirit to enlarge His flow through you.
- You will embrace the Kingdom of God that the Father longs to give us, including His holy, healing Kingdom emotions.
- You will reject the lies from the Old Nature and embrace the New Creation truths revealed in Scripture and in your heart.
- You will more fully lay aside your own wisdom and strength, depending totally on the Spirit of God to transform you and lead you into the amazing future He has for you.
- You will roar at your enemy, as you see the Lion of Judah roaring beside you!
- You will intensify your prayers, crying out to God in faith several times a day.

Standards for Grading Assignments

As indicated below, "C" or 2.0 level work is considered average. Leaders are not average people. You are therefore expected (required) to put forth the effort necessary to demonstrate at least "B" (3.0) level work or higher on all assignments which you submit. Any which do not will be returned to you with input from your instructor on how you can raise your grade to the expected level. A course grade will not be given until your assignments demonstrate that you have understood the material presented in the course and allowed your life to be transformed by the Spirit and the Word studied — the requirements for attaining a "B".

Your individual assignments (notebooks, tests, reports) will be graded according to the following standards. These grades will be averaged together to determine your course grade. Remember, we are training leaders and leaders are above-average people. Your work will reflect that.

- "D" Indicates barely passing work that is inferior to the average both in quantity and in quality.
 - Manifests a lack of initiative or sense of responsibility or both.
- Average work; either steady work of an acceptable quality, or work of a high quality which is uneven, irregular or fragmentary.
 - May be mechanically or outwardly correct but shows little reflection upon or personal assimilation of the material.
- "B" Intelligently has fulfilled the requirements of this course.
 - Understands the subject matter presented and has applied it to his life in a limited manner but has not really made the truths his own.
- 'A" Grasped the material with thoroughness, industry and correctness of detail.
 - Made the material his own by thinking about it and integrating it, using originality, natural ability, and insight.

- You will watch for dreams and visions from the Lord that reveal the real you as He sees you, then ponder them in your heart.
- You will recognize when you are being double-minded and learn to fill your day with only positive, lifegiving, health-producing thoughts and pictures.
- You will recognize and depend on the energy of the Holy Spirit within you and flowing through you as you walk through your days.
- You will embrace compassion as a high-value priority in kingdom living.
- You will consciously practice the skills you need to ride the waves of God's compassion until they become automatic.
- You will experience clearing of your cellular memories that result in healing of your body.
- You will speak only God's words and express only His thoughts.
- You will see Satan as he really is and yourself as you really are.
- You will begin experimenting with new kinds of prayers and refreshing ones you have used in the past.

- 5. Earn at least a "B" on the two tests.
- 6. Write a final paper discussing what you have learned in this course, how you have applied it, and the ways in which the Lord has changed you through what you have learned. This paper is to be a minimum of five pages and is due in the final lesson.
