Words of Knowledge

Course Description:

This course is designed to activate and strengthen you in the manifestation of words of knowledge out of a heart of love. Hearing God for yourself and others is central to being used in this exciting way and therefore is central to this course. You will be encouraged to take risks by stepping out in faith while remaining accountable for your motivation and your accuracy. If you love God and share His heart for people, developing your walk in words of knowledge can be invaluable in evangelism, healing, miracles, and just making a love connection that convinces others that God really does know them and is thinking about them.

(Prerequisites: REN103/503 Communion with God, PRO205/525 Prophetic Ministry, AND PRO207/527 Prophetic Foundations)

- You will discuss the glory of God and what it means that it covers the earth.
- You will discuss the relationship between your role and your identity.
- You will regularly track your prophecies to help you grow in your prophetic gifting.
- You will eagerly embrace feedback and establish accountability in your prophetic ministry.
- You will discuss your personal responsibility and authority concerning prophetic words spoken to you.
- You will discuss the place of risk in the prophetic ministry.
- You will discuss at least four ways in which you can weigh, judge, discern or distinguish prophecy.
- You will discuss five principles for creating an environment in which people can grow in the prophetic ministry.
- You will thrive in all the ways God intends you to in whatever environment you are in.

 You will state and use the five questions Bolz asks God when he is praying for someone but not hearing anything.

- 1. Prayerfully read *Words of Knowledge Made Easy* as assigned.
 - a. Answer the questions about the text found here in your Student Notebook. **NOTE: Save your answers into a digital document for easy transmitting to your instructor.**
 - b. Activations: Practice is the most effective tool you have for increasing your prophetic ministry. Therefore, regularly stepping out in guided activities will be an integral part of this course. This text includes four activations, with recommendations to complete each for four days. For this course, you will be doing more than that. The goal is that you will be aware of God speaking to you throughout your day as a natural part of your life. Follow the instructions in the text and in your Course Schedule. Each day, write a brief summary of what you did and the results.
 - c. After you complete the assigned number of each activation, write a summary of the experience. These summaries will be submitted to your instructor as email attachment so prepare it as a digital document for easy transmitting to your instructor.
- Prayerfully read the *Translating God* book as assigned. Complete the related exercises found here in your Student Notebook. NOTE: Save your answers into a digital document for easy transmitting to your instructor.

Standards for Grading Assignments

As indicated below, "C" or 2.0 level work is considered average. Leaders are not average people. You are therefore expected (required) to put forth the effort necessary to demonstrate at least "B" (3.0) level work or higher on all assignments which you submit. Any which do not will be returned to you with input from your instructor on how you can raise your grade to the expected level. A course grade will not be given until your assignments demonstrate that you have understood the material presented in the course and allowed your life to be transformed by the Spirit and the Word studied — the requirements for attaining a "B".

Your individual assignments (notebooks, tests, reports) will be graded according to the following standards. These grades will be averaged together to determine your course grade. Remember, we are training leaders and leaders are above-average people. Your work will reflect that.

- "D" Indicates barely passing work that is inferior to the average both in quantity and in quality.
 - Manifests a lack of initiative or sense of responsibility or both.
- "C" Average work; either steady work of an acceptable quality, or work of a high quality which is uneven, irregular or fragmentary.
 - May be mechanically or outwardly correct but shows little reflection upon or personal assimilation of the material.
- "B" Intelligently has fulfilled the requirements of this course.
 - Understands the subject matter presented and has applied it to his life in a limited manner but has not really made the truths his own.
- 'A" Grasped the material with thoroughness, industry and correctness of detail.
 - Made the material his own by thinking about it and integrating it, using originality, natural ability, and insight.

- 3. Prayerfully read the lessons in *Translating God Workbook* as assigned.
 - a. Answer the "Discussion or Thought Points" questions in a digital document to be submitted to your instructor as an email attachment. These are personal questions about your experiences so sometimes your answer will simply be "no." Don't take the easy way out; be honest in answering each question. They are for your benefit.
 - b. The "Activations" are designed for use in a group setting and therefore not necessarily appropriate in your situation. If you are in a church, small group or class in which you are able to follow the instructions for these activations, they will be a great benefit to you. If you are working on your own and are passionate about more intentionally walking in words of knowledge, you could ask the Lord for creative ways for you to do the Activations. However, they are not required to be completed for the course.
 - c. In addition to the "Discussion and Thought Points" in the Workbook, there are questions related to some chapters found in the Exercises section of this Student Notebook. Complete them as assigned in a digital document to be submitted to your instructor.

- 4. Carefully watch the *Translating God* video sessions *as assigned*.
 - a. NOTE: The order of the videos does not match the order of the chapters or lessons. Your Assignment Schedule will instruct you which video to watch in which lesson to line up the subject matter as much as possible.
 - b. Take notes as you watch each video. Shawn Bolz is a story-teller so his sessions are saturated with exciting testimonies. However, because of his extensive experience, he has also achieved great wisdom in the prophetic ministry and the video sessions are sprinkled with important principles that will help you grow and be more successful in the prophetic. Take note of these principles as you watch so you don't forget them.
 - c. After watching each video, take a few minutes to allow the Lord to speak to you about what you saw and heard. Ask Him what He especially wanted to say to you through the session.
 - d. NOTE: Your notes and journaling will be submitted so prepare them as a digital document to email to your instructor.
- 5. Earn at least a "B" on your Final Test.
